Directions to Education Building: enter main gate at intersection of Snelling Avenue and Dan Patch.
Make first right at Cosgrove and go one block. Education Building is on the right.

RENT PER TABLE \$45.00. (\$55.00 non-member). • No one day rentals. • Table size is 2½ ft. x 8 ft.

The exhibitor who is named on the application **must attend** the tables reserved in his/her name, is responsible for following the show rules of conduct, and federal and local regulations. Exhibitor passes are issued accordingly. If you want a written confirmation of your reservation, enclose a stamped, self-addressed envelope. If you require electrical service, there will be an additional charge determined by the facility.

PAYMENT MUST ACCOMPANY APPLICATION.

To qualify for refund on tables cancelled, you must cancel by Monday prior to public opening of the show. While the M.W.C.A. recognizes the need for some exhibitors to break down prior to the close of the show (Sunday, 3:00 P.M.) we ask that you remain in place the entire show hours as a courtesy to the paying public. Exhibitors who make early departures will be located in an area where their exit will not have a negative effect on the show, or may be denied tables at future shows.

- No subletting of tables.
- No sales to anyone under age 18 unless that person is accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- No animals allowed other than service animals.

ARTICLE VII Show Rules of Conduct

- SECTION 1: Exhibits and displays all types of arms and their accessories, along with the Association membership and guest attendance, constitute the primary goals of our Association Show Meetings.
- SECTION 2: Illegal arms and bulk explosives (excluding empty powder containers) shall not be brought in the Meeting Hall.
- SECTION 3: The display area referred to shall be understood to comprise only the table surface or surfaces contracted for, and no other. Uncontracted for or vacated tables, other horizontal surfaces, areas under tables, aisle space, adjacent wall areas and all other similar surfaces may not be used for display.
- SECTION 4: No playing of electronic media with audio.
- SECTION 5: Any item brought to a meeting which, in the opinion of a majority of the Board Members present, is detrimental to the safety or best interest of this corporation shall be barred. No loaded firearms except for authorized security personnel.
- SECTION 6: ALL firearms including airguns must be strapped. All loose ammunition shall be bagged, boxed, wrapped or under display case. Collector cartridges may be exempted by show personnel or BOD's. No loose ammunition displayed with firearms.

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Prohibited Items:

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| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Books and manuals on government overthrow or anarchy! ■ Bumper stickers and hats. Exception: Bumper stickers and hats may be sold or given away only by nonprofit organizations whose sole purpose is to promote shooting and gun ownership. Bumper stickers and hats must be shooting or firearms related! ■ Camp stoves, handheld flashlights, lanterns, sleeping bags and tents. ■ Coins, currency, stamps. ■ Communications and photo equipment ■ Dummy ammunition in firearms. ■ Flea market items including belt buckles (unless arms and accessories related), bottles, gems, glassware, jewelry, jewels, minerals, rocks and toys. ■ Any other item or action that is not, in the opinion of show management, in the best interest of MWCA and the public. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ General antiques. ■ Machinery, scrimshaw, timepieces and tools not related to arms and accessories. ■ Martial Arts items (Ninja), examples: throwing stars, nunchucks, throwing balls, etc. ■ New and used clothing (except new conceal carry clothing items). ■ Parts, kits, manuals, instruction books, etc., for the conversion of legal items to illegal items, or the making of bombs, silencers, machine guns, etc. ■ Smoke bombs, military and survival flares, bulk gun powder and tannerite. |
